

CADETTE, SENIOR & AMBASSADOR Community Service Bar Application (page 1 of 2)

There are three types of Community Service Bars that girls are eligible to receive:

•	The Cadette Girl Scout Community Service Bar (Red)
•	The Senior Girl Scout Community Service Bar (Orange)
•	The Ambassador Girl Scout Community Service Bar (Yellow)

Follow these required steps toward earning and acquiring the Community Service Bar:

- 1. The girl identifies the organization for which she would like to volunteer.
- 2. The girl approaches the organization to convey interest in volunteering, gain understanding of the organization's needs, explain the requirements for this Award and decides to proceed.
- 3. The organization agrees to train the girl for a minimum of 4 hours before moving to the next step. NOTE: The organization reserves the right to require more than 4 hours for training volunteers.
- 4. The girl completes a minimum of 20 service hours. This does not include the training period.
- 5. Use this Time Log to record the training hours (min. of 4) and volunteer hours (min. of 20)*.
- 6. The girl obtains approval/authentication from the organization's representative on the Time Log.
- 7. The girl obtains approval/authentication from her Troop Leader on the Time Log**.
- 8. Submit this entire application form to customercare@gssef.org.
- 9. Receive confirmation via email and...
- 10. Show the confirmation to a team member at either GSSE Retail Store to purchase the Award.

*Girl Scouts who have earned the Community Service Bar may continue their community service with the same organization after bridging to Senior or Ambassador Grade Levels. Girls should begin a new Time Log for the new Grade Level. For continuing service in this fashion, the 4 hour training is not required. However, if a girl selects a new organization, the 4 hours of training is required with the new organization.

** Parent signature is accepted, in lieu of Troop Leader, for individually registered member (IRM).

NOTE: Girls' volunteer hours for earning the Community Service Bar may NOT include the same time as those hours counted towards the required minimum for earning the Bronze, Silver, or Gold Awards.
