### **Principal Duties:**

- Meet with Camp Director daily
- Communicate directly with staff regarding campers with any administration, health or safety concerns.
- Attend staff training and meetings, as directed
- Support the philosophy, goals and objectives of Girl Scouting and GSSEF
- Ability to cope and act wisely in an emergency or crisis
- Provide swim testing for campers
- Supervise other lifeguards with scheduling
- Make sure all pools are kept up to standard with the Rangers
- Ability to be flexible and help with a plan 'B' if needed

### **Qualifications:**

- Minimum 21 years of age
- Currently certified in First Aid/CPR and have the American Red Cross or equivalent
- Experience in record keeping, programming and camping

### **Essential Requirements:**

- Supervisory experience
- Ability to give and receive information clearly by telephone and in person
- Ability to clearly communicate verbally and in writing with children and parents
- Knowledge of basic risk management practices
- Ability to travel to and between camp properties and ability to provide own transportation
- Ability to lift and transport up to forty (40) lbs
- Ability to stand for long periods of time
- Desire to work and live in a camp community
- Willingness and availability to meet parents/campers at two Camp Open Houses (May 22-23)
- Critical thinking skills and adaptability
