



## **Habitat for Humanity: Adventures in Scouting Patch Program Requirements**

To earn the Habitat for Humanity: Adventures in Scouting patch girls need to complete the following:

- Daisy Girl Scouts: 1 activity
- Brownie Girl Scouts: 3 activities
- Junior Girl Scouts: 4 activities
- Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador Girl Scouts: 5 activities

### **ACTIVITY #1: Homes and Neighborhoods**

Everyone has basic needs such as food, water, shelter and clothing. Explore how these needs are met by completing at least one of the activities in Module 1 of the Girls Build Curriculum.

### **ACTIVITY #2: Building Homes**

Learn the steps to building a home or other structure. Understand the processes and people involved by completing at least one of the activities in Module 2 of the Girls Build Curriculum.

### **ACTIVITY #3: Home Buying Basics**

Do you know the difference between owning and renting a home? Choose at least one of the exercises in Module 3 of the Girls Build curriculum to learn more about the advantages and disadvantages of home ownership.

### **ACTIVITY #4: Habitat for Humanity**

Learn about substandard housing through the eyes of girls around the world and how Habitat for Humanity is helping families build healthy and safe homes. Choose at least one of the exercises in Module 4 of the Girls Build Curriculum.

### **ACTIVITY #5: Giving Back**

Giving back will introduce the steps involved in planning and carrying out a community service project. Learn about the benefits of volunteering and how you can use your skills and abilities to help others. Choose at least one of the exercises in Module 5 of the Girls Build Curriculum.

### **ACTIVITY #6: Site visit**

Spend 2-3 hours volunteering on a Habitat work site or for another community organization. Celebrating and recognizing your contributions to the volunteer project are essential. Take a few minutes to write down your ideas for celebrating a job well done.
