BEADED SUN CATCHER - Not your regular sun catcher. This is a work of art. Hang beads from a stick or pole and hang it in your window for the sun to catch the beads.

BEGINNING HIP HOP - Move to the beat. Teach your girls the latest dance moves. All Levels

BIRD/NATURE HIKE - Bring binoculars and watch for birds and see the plants of Nocatee. Listen for warblers, spot owls, seek out the different herons and find out if you can touch that pretty plant.

BOONDOGGLE - Also known as lanyard. Weave, braid, twist and knot colorful strands of plastic laces into interesting projects. You can make, key chains, cup clips, zipper pulls, animals, bracelets and more.

BREAKFAST OUTDOOR COOKING - Have you ever cooked muffins in an orange or eggs in a paper bag? Join us for breakfast and learn what you and your girls can do on your next camping trip. (Class starts at 8 A.M.)

CEREMONIES - Come learn how to make your ceremonies special. Learn flag, investiture, rededication, bridging and more.

CHOCOLATE DESSERTS - This class will give you tips and tricks of how to create candies and desserts for each Girl Scout level. Learn how to make fun and innovative desserts for troop activities. Great for Daisies through Ambassadors!

COMPASS - Do you get lost in the woods? Learn to find your way out with a compass.

CRAFTS FOR THE CRAFT CHALLENGED - Do you feel craft challenged? This is the class for you. Easy crafts to make with your girls. We will start with a bookmark and go forward from there.

DOLLS AND PUPPETS - Make a stick Mummy, a cardboard tube dog marionette and a glove octopus. Easy crafts for Daisies and Brownies.

DUCT TAPE PURSE - Get stuck on Duct Tape. Make a purse and wallet out of this versatile material. Great for juniors on up.

FABRIC PHOTO ALBUM - Cover that boring album in fabric and lace. Juniors through Ambassadors will love making these to give away as gifts.

FAIRY WINGS AND WANDS - Daisies on up will enjoy making these magical wings and wands out of wire hangers and hose. They can use them as a costume or hang them on their walls.

FELT SWAP POUCH - Attach your swaps or decorate with a cute character appliqué. **Some hand sewing and creativity are required.**

GLASS ETCHING - Learn how to make beautiful designs on glass and mirrors. You will be able to etch sun catchers, mirrored trivets, vases and more. Turn an ordinary piece of glass into a masterpiece.

HAND PAINTED WINE GLASSES - Love the look of painted wine glasses but hate the price? Learn how to paint your own that will look like you bought them in an expensive store. You can use the same technique to paint any kind of glass, vase or jar. All levels will love it.

INTRODUCTION TO PADDLING - For the beginner or inexperienced paddlers. Skills being taught are: Types of canoes and equipment, strokes and how to paddle in tandem. This class does **NOT** certify you to take girls canoeing.

"JAMMIN' JOURNALS" - Decorate composition books, using scrapbooking paper and accessories, then they can be used as a journal or a diary. All levels

JEWEL BEADED BONSAI TREE - A work of art made from wire and beads. You will want to make this for your own home and your girls will love it. Juniors and up.

LETTERBOXING - Do your girls like to solve clues? It's the latest thing being done in parks all over. Go on a treasure hunt at Nocatee.

MACRAME OWL NECKLACE - Are you an owl maniac? Come make a GS Leader inspired necklace. Once the basic knots are mastered, a novice can make it in less than an hour. Campers love it.

MEMORY BOARDS - Decorate boards with fabric and ribbon. Great to show off pictures and other memories.

MONKEY & GEISHA T-SHIRTS - Bring 2 t-shirts, and paint a cute monkey and a geisha girl on them. Easy enough for brownies, they make great troop shirts for all levels.

MOSAIC VOTIVE - You can make a mosaic votive by recycling scraps of tissue paper you save from holiday gifts. Choose from a variety of glass shapes and let's get busy.

NO SCOUT LEFT INSIDE - Playing and exploring the Out of Doors makes a healthier and happier childhood. So shut down the Wii, turn off the I-pod and let's learn some easy games. Each game may have a hidden eco-lesson but it's really all about the fun.

NO SEW PILLOW - Can't thread a needle? Learn to make a fleece pillow cover without the hassle of sewing.

OUTDOOR CRAFTS - Easy crafts to make outdoors with your troop. We will be painting with sand, making a coffee filter butterfly and more.

PLAYING WITH YOUR FOOD - Come join the fun as we take things out of the pantry and into the playroom (and elsewhere). Your kitchen can become a chemistry set, a toy factory or a cosmetics business. The mystery of mixtures await.

POP UP PUPPETS - Learn to make this one-of-a-kind toy that will entertain all ages. Easy to make for older brownies on up.

PRINCESS BRACELETS - Learn to make a basic and more complex bracelet from soda tabs. Let your imagination run wild to create stunning bracelets for any occasion. All Ages

RIBBON PILLOW - Make a cute no-sew pillow. Weave different color ribbons to form a colorful front. Attach the front to a fleece back by tying the ribbons.

ROUND, ROUND GET AROUND - Introduce your troop to harmony with a round. We'll sing favorite GS rounds and learn some new ones. Once home again, you will have your troop singing all around. We'll do a few circle games and dances too.

SNUGGLES AND CUDDLES - A Council patch that is easy to earn with your girls. Recycle old blankets into Snuggles and Cuddles for the animal shelters. Learn to make homemade dog biscuits.

STEINER FELT DOLLS - Sew a simple cute doll with scraps of felt, yarn, and other materials. **Hand sewing required.**

S*W*A*P*S - Special*Whatchamacallits*Affectionately *Pinned* Somewhere or swap with a pal. Come learn the history and etiquette of swaps and make a few to take home.
