



CAMP TELOGIA, PARKLAND GENERAL INFORMATION

1. LOCATION OF CAMP, SIZE OF CAMP AND USE BY AGE LEVEL, TROOPS/GROUPS:

6501 Holmberg Road, Parkland, FL 33067.
The camp is 12.8 acres located north of Sawgrass Expwy, west of State Road 7 on Holmberg Road in Parkland. (See map)
Facilities are provided for daytime activities for Daisy's and daytime activities and Troop/Group Camping for Brownie, Junior, Cadette, Senior and Ambassador age levels.

4. CHECK IN/CHECK OUT TIMES:

Arrangements to be made at time of Camp registration.

5. CAMP KEYS: Pick-up & Return:

To be picked up from either Service Center (Jupiter or Oakland Park).

6. CARS: One (1) Emergency vehicle at each campsite only. **All other vehicles must be parked in the parking lot.**

7. AMERICAN FLAG & FLAG POLE:

One flag and one flagpole on each site.

8. ELECTRICAL: Leave all breakers and appliances ON at all times, even when you leave. DO turn off all lights when you leave.

9. REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS: Do not adjust temperature or turn off. Upon departure; refrigerator/freezer should be completely emptied and shelves wiped down.

10. SLEEPING MATTRESSES: Stack neatly in storage room (or on overhead shelves in Green Thumb) upon departure. Mats should be wiped down if necessary, but dried before storage.

11. BUGS! ZAPPERS AND LIGHTS:
Turn off during daylight hours and upon departure.

12. Picnic benches and tables may be borrowed from unoccupied sites but must be **RETURNED** upon departure or occupation of site.

13. All garbage should be bagged and placed in dumpster. Do not leave garbage outside at night unless it is in the dumpster. Keep dumpster closed at all times.

14. Tents: upon departure, roll down and latch front flaps.

15. SITE #1 - Green Thumb: Troops and groups will use the troop house for sleeping; outdoor area for cooking and camp activities is at the rear of troop house. The troop house SLEEPS 20 and is ADA accessible.

16. SITE #2 - White Oaks: Troops and groups will use the 9 platform tents (4 to a tent) for sleeping. Equipment is in storage room in Troop House.

17. SITE #3 - Sunshine: Troops and Groups will use the 5 platform tents (4 to tent) for sleeping. Equipment is in storage room in troop House. ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~

18. GATE: The gate should be locked at all times when a troop/group is present. Be sure to lock the gate when you leave.

Check In & Set Up PROCEDURES

CHECK IN:

1. Stow troop gear in Unit House.
2. Take inventory.
3. Clean bathrooms.
4. Stow personal gear and settle in.
5. Put up Kaper Charts, etc.
6. NEVER use charcoal lighter fluid, gasoline, kerosene or other fluids.
- 7.. Build fires in designated areas only.
- 8.. Never leave fires unattended. Be sure fire is DEAD OUT before leaving it.
- 9.. Make sure you have a bucket of water & sand next to fire ring before building your fire.
10. Make sure everyone has their hair tied back & in a fire scarf.

BATH HOUSE:

1. Don't wash dishes in sinks.
2. Don't clean and prepare food in these sinks.
3. Provide garbage bags for all garbage cans.
4. Provide a separate container for sanitary napkins (small paper bag).

GARBAGE AND TRASH:

1. Troops/Groups are responsible for bringing 30-gallon plastic garbage bags and fasteners to line garbage cans. Garbage must be disposed of in dumpster.

CARE OF TENTS:

1. Check tents for any damage, needing repairs before and after use.
2. Report on inventory sheet, any repairs needed.
3. Four (4) girls per tent. Same for adults.

Adults with adults not girls.

4. DO NOT use any sprays such as insect repellent, hair spray or deodorant inside of the tent.
5. All males Must sleep in a separate tent.
6. NO food, drinks, candy, gum, etc. should be allowed in tents at any time. It attracts bugs and animals.
7. Do not touch canvas tents when wet. It will cause leaks.
8. Tent ropes are not clotheslines. Put up a Clothesline and dunk bag.
9. Upon departure, roll down and latch from flaps.

**CLEAN-UP &
CHECK OUT PROCEDURES**

UNIT HOUSE:

1. Remove all troop/group supplies from the unit house.
2. Remove all troop items from the Bulletin Board.
3. Wipe all tables & benches down.
4. Sweep floor.
5. Turn out lights and lock door.

KITCHEN/STORAGE AREA:

1. Wipe clean all mattresses and replace in storage room. Do not put mattresses away wet.
2. Clean inside & out of refrigerator, Wipe dry. Do not leave bag of ice.
3. Return all camp equipment to proper place neatly, clean & dry.
4. Wipe all shelves. Do not leave toilet paper/paper towels.
5. Take inventory.
6. Remove all garbage and rinse out garbage cans.
7. Sweep floor.
8. Lock doors.

GROUNDS:

1. "Police" grounds for debris.
