- Ability to cope and act wisely in an emergency or crisis
- Ability to be flexible and help with a plan 'B' if needed

Qualifications:

- Minimum 21 years of age
- Currently licensed driver in the State of Florida
- Experience in originating, updating, and/or monitoring campers and staff
- Experience in record keeping, programming and camping

- Ability to give and receive information clearly by telephone and in person
- Ability to clearly communicate verbally and in writing with children, parents, physicians, volunteers, peers, supervisors, and subordinates
