- Ability to cope and act wisely in an emergency or crisis
- Test campers in their ability to swim
- Help with canoeing if assigned
- Other duties as assigned

**Qualifications:**

- Minimum 17 years of age
- Experience in lifeguarding a plus

- Ability to clearly communicate verbally and in writing
- Currently certified in CPR/First Aid and have current lifeguarding through American Red Cross or equivalent
- Ability to lift and transport up to forty (40) lbs
- Ability to stand for long periods of time
- Desire to work and live in a camp community
- Willingness and availability to meet parents/campers at two Camp Open Houses (May 22-23)
