To be considered for this scholarship, a Girl Scout must:

- Have earned the Girl Scout Gold Award (current year recipients will also be considered);
- Demonstrate the Girl Scout characteristics of courage, confidence, and character;
- Have exhibited a true commitment to her community through service, outside of her Gold Award, that has had a significant impact on a group or individual.
- Be a senior in high school who has already been accepted into a college or university or is already enrolled in undergraduate classes
- Complete a 500-word essay on how being a Girl Scout has changed her understanding about what serving community means and how this has prepared her for the future (provide specific examples of community service projects outside of the Gold Award project).

This year, the recipient of the **Paul C. Emmett MVP Champion of the Community** will receive \$1,500 toward her studies at the college or university she is attending.

**Submission Process:**

Applications for this year’s scholarship are due April 15, 2019. Late applications cannot be accepted. The recipient will be announced at our 2019 Gold Award Ceremony on May 11, 2019 (see above).
