Badge Overview

Playing fair means that everyone has the same chance to play, because everyone follows the same rules. That's what this badge is all about. You'll learn to work together to have the most fun possible. That's fair play!

Badge Components

1. Follow the rules

Games have rules to ensure that everyone knows how to play fairly! Earn this step by selecting one of the games below and teaching a friend or family member the rules and how they keep things fair. If you don't already know the rules yourself, be sure to look them up with your parent's permission first.

- Simon Says
- Red Light, Green Light
- Four Corners

2. Include everyone

Women and girls haven't always been allowed to play sports in their school and community, or professionally! Earn this step by finding 2 professional women's sports groups, associations, and/or leagues.

- When did they start?
- Find the men's version and compare when they started.

3. Be part of a team

Earn this step by completing one of the options below!

- Team of Two—watch this [video](#) and try out the 4 partner yoga poses they do with a friend or family member!
- Team of Four or More—play a game of the human knot! Have everyone stand in a circle facing inwards. Everyone will put both hands in the middle, and then grab hands with two other people in the circle (make sure each hand is connected to someone different). Now your team must work together to untangle yourselves without letting go of anyone's hand!

4. Keep score

Earn this step by completing the matching game on the [worksheet](#)! Which scoring word goes with which sport?

5. Have a field day

Earn this step by creating your own rules for a game that your family and/or friends can play!

- Pick one off the three games from step 1 and make it your own by changing a rule or adding a new one. Make at least 2 changes/additions, and be sure to teach everyone the new way to play so it can be fair!
