Badge Overview

You can have fun without a computer, a deck of cards, or even a ball. Games are everywhere when you use your imagination to make them up! Try this badge, and you and your friends will never be bored again.

Badge Components

1. Try a scavenger hunt

The word “scavenge” means to search for something. Earn this step by creating a scavenger hunt of your own!

- You can do an alphabet scavenger hunt by finding 1 item from inside or outside your house that starts with each letter of the alphabet.

2. Make up a mystery game

Many people like games that work their minds and require brain power. Earn this step by creating a mystery game, like one that focuses on one the senses- taste, touch, smell, hearing, and sight!

- For example, you could do a blindfolded taste test where the person playing must taste something while blindfolded and try to guess what it is!

3. Create a party game

People love to play games at parties, and relay races are a great way to bring a group together in competition. Earn this step by creating your own relay race!

- What are the rules?
- Will people go one at a time?
- Do you need any supplies?
- How will you know when someone has won?

4. Change the rules

There are many classic games that people know the rules to. Earn this step by adding a new rule to one of the games below, or another game you love, that makes it more challenging and fun!

- Musical Chairs
- Duck, Duck, Goose
- Freeze Tag

5. Invent a whole new sport

There are so many different kinds of sports played around the world! Earn this step by first thinking of your favorite sport.

- Keep one part of that sport, like the field it’s played on, the ball used, or the number of people on a team.
- Then, change everything else to create your own sport!
- Be sure to write down the name, how many players there are, any equipment that is used, how you score and win, and any other rules!
