



My Family Story



Badge Overview

Find out more about your family—the people you love and who love you. When you've earned this badge, you'll know how to tell your family story.

Badge Components

1. Explore family stories

Earn this step by watching a movie, two TV shows, or read two books about a family. How are the families like your own? How are they different?

2. Know where your family is from

Earn this step by asking people in your family about your family history and find out which different countries, states, or towns your family comes from.

- Are there any traditions that have been passed down from a long time ago? Is there a special family recipe that your family likes to cook? Are there holidays that are unique to your family's culture?

3. Make a story tree

Earn this step by drawing or painting a family tree that shows all of your family members. Make sure to include a fun fact about each person!

4. Find an object that means something to your family

- With your family's help, earn this step by finding an object that has either been handed down or belongs to someone that lives far away. Ask about any stories that are related to the object!
- If you can't find an object, or you would like to do this option instead, earn this step by looking at old photos with your family. Ask about what was happening when the photo was taken!

5. Share your family story

Earn this step by calling a family member who doesn't live with you and tell them all about what you've learned while earning this badge!

Materials

- Paper
- Pencil
- Crayons, color pencils, or markers
- An object that means something to your family, or old family photos
- A phone
