Daisies earn petals that go around the Promise Center to complete their Daisy flower. The Clover petal is one of ten petals you can earn, each representing a line of the Girl Scout Law. When you've earned your Clover petal, you'll know how to use resources wisely, just like Clover.

Badge Components

1. Talk about "Clover's Story"

- How did Clover use resources wisely?
- What do you think would have happened to the leftover yogurt and apples if Clover hadn't suggested making a dip?
- When have you been resourceful? Can you think of other ways to be resourceful?

2. Make a collage using old magazines or postcards

Earn this step at home by creating a collage of your own garden! You can use magazines, newspapers, postcards, and any other materials and art supplies you already have around your home.

3. Practice being resourceful
