Badge Overview



Through earning this badge, Daisies will learn how to get creative in the outdoors and enjoy art in nature.

Badge Components

1. See the colors of nature

Head out to your backyard with a paper and crayons. Take a deep breath and look all around you.

- What colors do you see?
- Use your paper to draw the colors of nature in your yard.

2. Hear the sounds of nature

Lay on a blanket in the middle of your backyard and close your eyes. Take a deep breath and listen to everything around you.

- What nature sounds do you hear?
- What city sounds do you still hear?
- Make a list or drawing of what you hear.

3. Share your outdoor art

Time to get creative! Head out back and gather some natural items for your project. Remember, if its not on the ground, leave it be; it's still growing and should be left for others to enjoy.

- Use glue to create a collage of the things you collected. Add to your collage with drawings of the living things you saw outside like flowers, trees and animals.
- Be sure to send in a picture of your finished art to GSSEF to share with other Girl Scouts.

Materials

- Paper
- Markers, crayons or color pencils
