Daisies earn petals that go around the Promise Center to complete their Daisy flower. The Tula petal is one of ten petals you can earn, each representing a line of the Girl Scout Law. When you've earned your Tula petal, you'll know how to be courageous and strong, just like Tula the Tulip.

### Badge Components

#### 1. Talk about "Tula's Story"

- When did Tula show that she was courageous and strong?
- How do you think Darla felt when Tula asked the dandelions to stop teasing her?
- How do you think the rest of the dandelions felt after Tula and then Miss Evergreen asked them to stop teasing Darla?

#### 2. Make an art gallery celebrating women who are courageous and strong

With a family member, earn this step at home by finding the story of a courageous and strong woman. It can be someone you know or someone you don't. Then draw a picture of her!

#### 3. Practice being courageous and strong

Earn this step by trying out the activity below or coming up with your own way to be courageous and strong!
