Badge Overview

Through earning this badge, Senior Girl Scouts will learn how to create and enjoy art in the outdoors.

Badge Components

1. Explore art outdoors

Take a walk or ask your parent to take you for a ride in the car. Locate at least three outdoor works of art. Sculptures, statues, murals or any other form of art found outside. Garden art counts too! Take a journal with you to sketch or jot down your thoughts about the art. Here are some links to get your imagination flowing on outdoor art to explore.

2. Make something

Sit outside and take in everything around you. The colors, textures, smells. Head back inside and get creative. Use your inspiration from the outdoors to create something. It can be a sketch of something you noticed, a bracelet with the colors of a sunset, or the birds you heard singing in the trees.

3. Create or share music inspired by nature

Create a TikTok or Snapchat of natural sounds and human-made sounds. Then share it and see which sounds your friends hear.

4. Capture nature digitally

Pull out that smartphone and snap some shots of nature using different filter options. Try downloading a photo app to have even more options as you channel your inner nature photographer. Share your photos with friends and talk about why they like the photo.

5. Design outdoors

Murals are pictures on walls or other flat surfaces. After heading outside for inspiration in your backyard or through the neighborhood, design a mural of something meaningful to you in nature. You can use any material that inspires you; pencils, crayons, paint or design it on your computer.
