This approach fosters courage, confidence, and character, equipping girls with the skills and experiences to thrive in all aspects of life.

Girl Scouts encourages girls to connect with others in a safe space, building positive relationships and a supportive peer network. The program is designed to connect girls with committed and caring adults who serve as mentors as they guide girls through new experiences, providing emotional support and a sense of belonging along the way.

Girls actively participate in shaping their own Girl Scout experience, choosing activities and taking ownership of their learning. This allows girls to explore their potential, try new things, and develop skills like problem-solving, innovation, collaboration, and using failure as a learning opportunity.

In addition, girls in Girl Scouting achieve higher academic success, are more likely to seek out STEM related careers, and have access to scholarships and resources that will transform their futures.



The Girl Scout Program

Girl Scouts of Southeast Florida delivers programs through the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, a dynamic, research-based, development program that equips today's girls in grades K-12 with the courage, confidence and character to learn, lead, and thrive. It's delivered through a collection of engaging, challenging, and fun activities like earning badges, going on awesome trips, selling cookies, exploring science, getting outdoors, and completing community service projects.

At Girl Scouts, everything centers around the girl and is designed to meet her where she is now and to grow along with her. Activities are girl-led, which gives girls the opportunity to learn by doing in a cooperative learning environment. They get to lead their own adventure and team up with other girls in an all-girl environment to choose the exciting, hands-on activities that interest them most.

We have identified Three Keys to Leadership that differentiates our program. Girls will: **Discover** themselves and their values; **Connect** with others; and **Take Action** to make the world a better place.

The four Girl Scout program pillars highlight the skills girls learn that will give them the courage, confidence, and character they need to make their community and their world a better place.

Research shows girls are keenly interested in science, technology, engineering, and math and excel at it. Yet girls often don't pursue STEM—starting as early as elementary school.
