

Camp Nocatee, Clewiston GENERAL INFORMATION

Address:

6009 Flaghole Road, Clewiston, FL 33440 The camp property is 640 acres (=1 square mile)

Facilities provide opportunities for overnight camping for all grade levels, as well as target sports (including archery and sling shots), canoeing, hiking, and wildlife observation.

Carson's Commons is the main camp area, comprised of several buildings, and includes the main Flagpole. Other structures include:

- Founder's Hall with commercial kitchen: large indoor activity space, dining center, small stage, piano, restrooms and covered front porch. No sleeping allowed.
- Cook's Cabin: cabin housing building for Food Handler, kitchen team, etc.
- **Infirmary:** cabin housing building for nurse, first aider(s), medical team, etc.
- **Staff House:** cabin housing building for staff members and/or volunteers.
- Semler Crafts & Nature Center: all- purpose room, with restroom. No sleeping allowed.
- Director's Cabin: cabin housing building for staff members and council storage. Not permitted for volunteer or girl use.
- Trading Post: building for GSSEF staff members only. Not permitted for volunteer or girl use. No sleeping allowed.

Barn and Archery Area is inside camp and provides a large, open-air covered barn with picnic tables where archery may be offered. Includes restrooms. No sleeping allowed.

Sports Court and Field: provides a hard court all-purpose area and large, open grassy area.

Langford Lake provides a Boathouse with restrooms and boat rack containing canoes; available for rental/use with approved supervision and instruction. Swimming is <u>NOT</u> permitted in the lake. Area also includes a barbecue pit (available upon request), covered shelter with picnic tables, and swimming pool.

Waterfront Cabin: cabin housing building for GSSEF staff members only. Not permitted for volunteer or girl use.

Sleeping Sites:

Site 1: Little Critter Village Site 2: Whispering Pines

Site 3: Daisy Depot Site 4: Rabbit's Foot

Site 5: Sleepy Hollow (ADA Accessible)

Sites 1-5 provide five cabins (maximum sleeping capacity = 8 each) and one unit house. Maximum sleeping capacity for Sites 1-5 = 40 individuals.

Site 6: Tree Tops is reserved for Cadettes, Seniors and Ambassadors. It provides three tree house cabins, each with maximum sleeping capacity = 8. Maximum sleeping capacity for Site 6 = 24 individuals. The unit house at Site 6 is ADA Accessible.
