Doreen was always “right at home” in nature. She was an avid camper, equestrian, fisherwoman, and tennis player. She deeply valued the Girl Scout experience she shared with her own girls, Katherine, and Theodora. She knew the leadership experience offered by Girl Scouts, combined with the organization’s long tradition of outdoor exploration and adventure was the perfect combination for helping girls grow strong and confident!

Forever Green Girl Scout Scholarship Application 2024

To qualify for this scholarship, a Girl Scout will:

- Be a currently registered member in the Girl Scouts of Southeast Florida Council;
- Be in 12th grade student (Ambassador Girl Scout Level) or currently enrolled undergraduate college/university student with 60 hours completed *or fewer*;
- Have earned the Girl Scout Gold Award (2024 recipients will be considered);
- Embody the Girl Scout characteristics of courage, confidence, and character;
- Have a deep appreciation for nature and the outdoors; and
- Submit a 500-word essay on the following topic: **How my love of nature was incorporated into my Gold Award project? Describe the most significant results in one or more of these key areas:** (a) environmental sustainability, (b) outdoor education, (c) outdoor sports, (d) horticulture, (e) wildlife advocacy, and/or (f) greenspace preservation.

Allocation & Distribution:

Scholarship money will be forwarded directly to the institution in the student's name upon the student providing proof of class registration and student identification number. A form will be provided to the scholarship recipient.

Submission:

- Applications are due **Wednesday, April 3, 2024 at 11:59 pm.** (Late applications cannot be accepted.)
- Send completed applications by email with the subject line, **Doreen A. Scott Forever Green Girl Scout Scholarship** to customercare@gssef.org.
- Include with this cover sheet with your 500-word essay, as described above.
- If you are a currently enrolled undergraduate college/university student with 60 hours completed *or fewer*, you must provide a transcript or other official documentation of current credit hours for Spring 2024 term. Note: the transcript is used to confirm credit hours, not student grades or GPA.
- The recipient will be honored at the GSSEF Gold Award Ceremony on May 11, 2024. Attendance is expected.
