What is food insecurity?

Food insecurity means that households are, at times, unable to acquire adequate food for one or more household members because they have insufficient money and other resources for food.

What hunger looks like in Florida:

- **2.2 million Floridians** lack access to healthy food
- **1 in 7 children** face hunger
- **Florida is ranked 10th in food insecurity and 8th in child food insecurity' (Savelle & O'Neal).** Florida's two most food-insecure counties are Gadsden and Leon.
