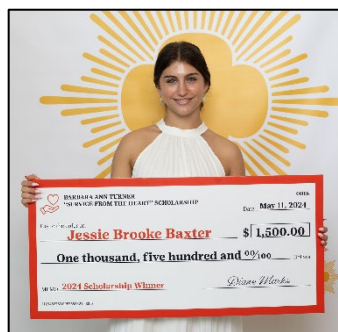

The scholarship presentation will be made at the GSSEF Gold Award Ceremony on May 9, 2026. The scholarship recipient is expected to attend this event in person. The scholarship recipient and two guests are invited to attend the event for free. Additional guest tickets will be available online for purchase.

# Barbara Ann Turner “Service from the Heart” Scholarship

Thank you for your interest in the Barbara Ann Turner “Service from the Heart” Scholarship. This is awarded annually to a one GSSEF Girl Scout who has given exceptional volunteer service to her community.

## Eligibility Qualifications:

- Be a currently registered member of Girl Scout in the Girl Scouts of Southeast Florida (GSSEF);
- Have maintained GSSEF membership for a minimum of 3 years;
- Be a current 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> Grader in the 25/26 academic year; and
- Has demonstrated commitment to community service with a minimum of 100 hours of service; with the majority of service dedicated to one organization in the local community.
- The recipient is expected to attend the ceremony on May 9, 2026 at the DoubleTree by Hilton Deerfield Beach Boca Raton, 100 Fairway Dr, Deerfield Beach, FL 33441 from 9 - 11:30 a.m.

## Application Procedure:

- Submit a personal essay with the required information (see list below) and submit it to: [customercare@gssef.org](mailto:customercare@gssef.org) with subject line “Barbara Ann Turner Scholarship” by April 6, 2026 at 11:59 p.m.
  - Provide this information at the top of the essay page, a simple bulleted list in this order will be sufficient:
    - Applicant’s full name, home address, cell phone number, and email address
    - Applicant’s age, current school grade, and full name of High School
    - Applicant’s total years as a Girl Scouts member
    - *For 12<sup>th</sup> graders only*: name of the college/university selected for attendance in the 25/26 academic year
    - Name of the organization where most of the volunteer service was performed, the organization’s Mission Statement, and the organization’s website address
    - Date range of volunteer service: Month/Year to Month/Year
    - Total number of hours of volunteer service for this organization
    - A brief description of the type of volunteer service performed
  - Essay, maximum of 500 words:
    - How you believe your primary organization provides a service to the community?
    - What did your service to the organization entail? Please be very specific.
    - Did you have any special training to perform this service? If yes, describe it.
    - What did the organization gain by your donation of service?
    - What did gain from your service and this experience?
    - How do you plan to use the scholarship money?
- Provide the Reference Form to 2 individuals who agree to support your application and return a letter of recommendation by April 6, 2026 at 11:59 p.m.

## Fund Allocation and Distribution:

- Should the recipient be in 12<sup>th</sup> grade, planning to enter college/university in Fall 2026, the form will be provided in June 2026 and funding allocated in August/September 2026.
- Should the recipient be in 11<sup>th</sup> grade, planning to enter college/university in Fall 2027, the form will be provided in Summer 2027 and funding allocated in August/September 2027. Please keep GSSEF updated with preferred email contact information.
- Scholarship funds will be forwarded directly to the institution in the student’s name.
