SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS:

Be a currently registered member of GSSEF;
Have maintained GSSEF membership for a minimum of 3 years;
Be a current 12th grader in the 24/25 academic year;
Have earned the Girl Scout Gold Award (2025 honorees are eligible); and
Submit an essay addressing these 3 prompts. Be sure to include details from Girl Scout experiences outside of your Gold Award experience too. 500 words max.

What does it mean to you to be a Girl Scout and how has it changed your life?
How do you feel being a Girl Scout will have a positive impact on your life after high school graduation?
What specific skills did you learn in Girl Scouts that will help you in your future academic and professional life?

HOW TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION:

Applications are due by April 7, 2025 at 11:59 p.m.
Submit applications by email with the subject line, Gold Award Advisors Girl Scout Scholarship to customercare@gssef.org
Submission must include a cover sheet with the essay, that includes the following:
Girl's full name, cell phone number, email address, year the Gold Award was earned, and name of college/university selected for attendance in the 25/26 academic year.
The recipient will be notified by May 1, 2025.
The recipient will be honored at the GSSEF Gold Award Ceremony on May 10, 2025.

FUND ALLOCATION & DISTRIBUTION:

Recipient will be provided a form (via email) to provide proof of class registration and student identification number for GSSEF. Scholarship funds will be forwarded directly to the institution in the student's name.
